Achievement: KP Group becomes first to install Windmill under **Hybrid Policy in South Gujarat**

KP Group has been marching ahead on the growth path. KP Group has achieved the distinction of installing the first wind turbine in South Gujarat under the hybrid policy. The project is progressing as per the personal analysis of KP Group's visionary CMD Faruk Patel. The company is in the process of installing seven wind turbines in Kora, Kavli, and Kangaam villages of Bharuch, while solar power plants have been established in Saarod and Saamoj villages. As of March-end, one wind turbine has been installed. Five wind turbines of 2.1MW and two turbines of 2.7MW are planned to be established under the project. The work is expected to be completed by April-May 2023. It is noteworthy that the development of the hybrid plant is being taken care of by the young blood in the team, which is a matter of great pride for the group.



Work continues on these projects

The under-development projects of KPI Green Energy and KP Energy include six hybrid projects at Saamoj, Bhungar and Unchadi. Work is in progress for 25 solar and wind power projects in Vagra, Tanchha, Ora, Ranada, Simartha, Shahpura, Veddchha, Jarsad, Simdhara and Karad villages. Most of these projects will be completed in the very near future. Of the ongoing projects, 15 are for 11 Kw line while ten projects are for 66 Kw line. The cumulative capacity of all these projects is 470MW.

KP Group's chest swelled with pride after group company KPI Green Energy won a deal to supply hybrid power to the Indian Air Force. On February 6, 2023, KPI Green Energy's Managing Director Faruk Patel and Air Force's Senior Administrative Officer Mr. Pravod Sood, Air Force Station, Jamnagar's Lt General (AF) Mr. Man Bhardwaj, Chief Engineer Mr. Mahendra Pal, Command Work Officer Anand Sir, and Deputy Director (EM) Mr. Lokesh

Goyal signed the agreement for the supply of 1.845 MWAc hybrid power at Gandhinagar. Non-executive Directors Smt Venu Birappa and Mr. Sharad Patil, and Assistant General Managers Javed Patel and Anurag Pal were present at the occasion on behalf of KP Group. The Air Force team shared information about the agreement on Twitter. Speaking on the occasion, Faruk Patel thanked the Air Force for the agreement and said it is a great honour for the company to serve the nation by providing green and sustainable renewable energy to the armed forces. KPI Green Energy will supply 1.845MWAc hybrid power for 20 years to the Jamnagar Air Force Station under the Independent Power Producer segment.

It is a matter of pride for the community that daughters are also here in this 100 Billionaires event. No power in the world can stop this community from marching ahead.

Your credit and personality play a very important role. Every country has a different currency. The values and cultures are different, but if you have credit, everything is available by default.

There was a time when I had to wait for an hour or even longer to encash a cheque of Rs. 20,000 at a money changer right here in Bharuch. The same money changer now comes to my office in Surat and requests me to suggest ways he can grow in life. What I want to say is that you work hard and take yourself to such heights that people will start appreciating you. They start appreciating your efforts. Every policy and administrative system will automatically come to your assistance once you attain a certain height.

Replying to former cricketer Munaf Patel's question as to how a doctor or engineer can become a billionaire, Faruk Patel said, "Why can they not?" My own son Affan Patel, who is a BE engineer, will complete works of Rs. 550 crore in a year. He has set up a team of 70 engineers. In the same way, a doctor can set up a team to establish a multispeciality hospital or enter the medicine business and achieve the desired heights. There are many such examples amongst us. What one needs is attitude. Of course, high qualification is also an absolute must. Someone with less education will not be able to rise beyond a point, but for someone who is highly qualified, the prospects of rising higher are greater. Munaf Patel became a wicket-taker only after practising lakhs of deliveries. Someone who is educated can move ahead on every delivery.

You can also enter an already established business, but the condition is that whatever you take up, work hard with dedication and passion. Work like crazy, even if others call you crazy.

There is nothing like failure. It is a part of the process of moving ahead and learning. Yes, if you have taken up something, but dropped it forever, it can be categorised as failure. But, the key is to keep getting up and climbing the stairs irrespective of how many times you fall.

To become a billionaire, you will have to behave like a billionaire and act like one. You will have to work in that direction.

KPI Green Energy and KP Energy on the path of progress; PAT of both companies rises sharply

The two listed companies of KP Group, i.e. NSE and BSE listed KPI Green Energy Limited and BSE-listed KP Energy Limited are firmly on the growth path. In the past year, both companies completed half a dozen projects before time, while as many projects are currently in the execution stage. As far as financial performance is concerned, KPI Green Energy reported revenue of Rs. 4,626 million in the first nine months of the financial year 2022-23, a growth of 197% compared with Rs. 1,558 million in the corresponding period of the previous fiscal. The Profit After Tax (PAT) jumped by 133% from Rs. 334 million to Rs. 779 million.

Similarly, KP Energy also reported excellent financial performance. For the first nine months of the year, the company's revenues increased from Rs. 1,428 million to Rs. 2,894 million, a growth of 103%. The PAT for the same period grew by 82% from Rs. 157 million to Rs. 284 million. The financial performance suggests both companies are poised to achieve strong growth in the coming quarters and years.




