God helps those who are brave

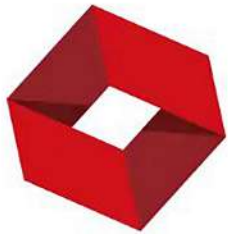
Defeat is accepted **when one gives up,**

when one is determined



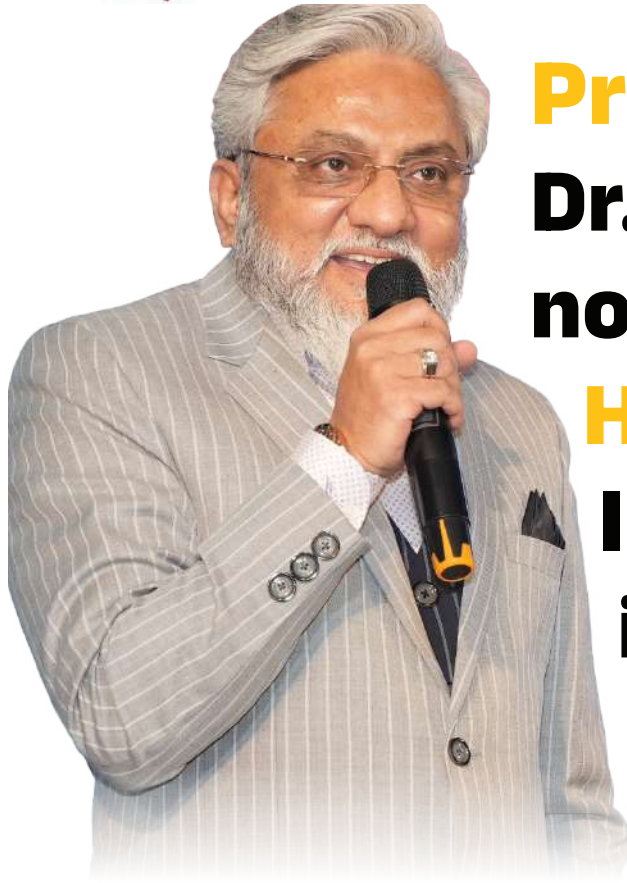

Discussion about Business and aid

On June 25, 2024, a delegation from KP Group, lead by CMD Dr. Faruk G. Patel and Whole Time Director Moinul Kadva, had a special meeting with the Honorable Chief Minister of Gujarat, Shri Bhupendrabhai Patel. There was a discussion about the development of renewable energy in Gujarat and KP Group's contribution

to it. The CSR arm of KP Group, KP Human Development Foundation, is constructing the world's first old age home for the specially-abled in Jhagadia, Bharuch at a cost of more than 12 crores. A report was also submitted about the development of this old age home. It is noteworthy that the foundation stone for this

old age home was laid by the Chief Minister in February 2023 and he has been repeatedly inquiring about its development. KP Human will build this old age home and hand it over to the Disabled Welfare Trust of India of Padmashri Dr. Kanubhai Tailor. The plan is to complete and hand over this old age home by the end of 2025.



KP Group CMD, Dr. Faruk G. Patel also had a courtesy meeting with the newly appointed Honorable Chief Minister of Maharashtra, Shri Eknath Shinde, and had discussions about the scope of renewable energy in state of Maharashtra in the coming years.

KP Group's financial results for FY 23-24 were declared. Impressive growth of 55.1% in revenue and 54.2% in PAT



Moving forward on the path of success, KP Group announced its financial results for FY23-24. The group recorded an impressive growth of 55.1% in Revenue and 54.2% in PAT. The group has announced these figures together with KPI Green Energy, KP Energy, and newly listed KP Green Engineering. Against Rs. 12,042.15 million in FY22-23, the group recorded a rise in revenue of Rs.18,683.30 million in FY23-24. Against this, Profit After Tax (PAT) has been recorded at Rs.2553.67 million against Rs.1656.60 million. The group's portfolio in renewables has so far been noted at 3.4 gigawatts. Of which, wind is 1.8 gigawatts, solar is 1.3 gigawatts, and hybrid is 334 MWs. The group has saved 41 lakh metric tons of carbon emissions so far.

According to the company, KPI Green Energy has recorded a growth of 59.3% in revenue and 47.5% in PAT, while KP Energy has recorded a growth of 9.8% in revenue and 32.8% in PAT, while KP Green Engineering has recorded a growth of 206.6% in revenue and 192% in PAT. It is noteworthy that KP Green Engineering was listed on the BSE's MSME platform only in March-2024.

KP Green Engineering's Hi-Tech Matar factory development work is in full swing

KP Green Engineering is constructing a large factory in the village of Matar, Bharuch district. Work is going on round the clock. This expansion project is part of other expansions going on at KP Green Engineering for which the company brought the largest SME IPO of Rs. 189.50 crore in March 2024, which was oversubscribed by 29.58 times. This project is going to cost Rs. 174.04 crore. Out of which Rs. 156.14 crore is going to be taken from the offer. The existing Dabhasa factory, spreads across 2 lakh square feet,

and currently has a production capacity of 53,000 MTs annually, which is planned to be increased to 294,000 MTs per year with this new expansion. This new factory is conveniently located near the Delhi-Mumbai Express Highway, ensuring smooth transportation. It will feature loading-unloading facilities, storage, and administrative offices. The factory which is being built in huge area of 64,494 square meter is expected to become fully operational by the end of FY 2024-25. The first stage of the plant is expected to

commence operations by the end of the year 2024. This new project, once becoming fully operational will expand the product portfolio of the company with a cutting-edge 56-meter-deep galvanizing plant, tubular wind towers, lattice towers, overhead bridges, monopole power transmission towers, pre-engineering buildings, and metal beam crash barriers, along with other heavy fabrication works. The factory will be equipped with automatic machinery for efficient and precise production.

The first old age home for the Specially-abled has reached its 1st phase

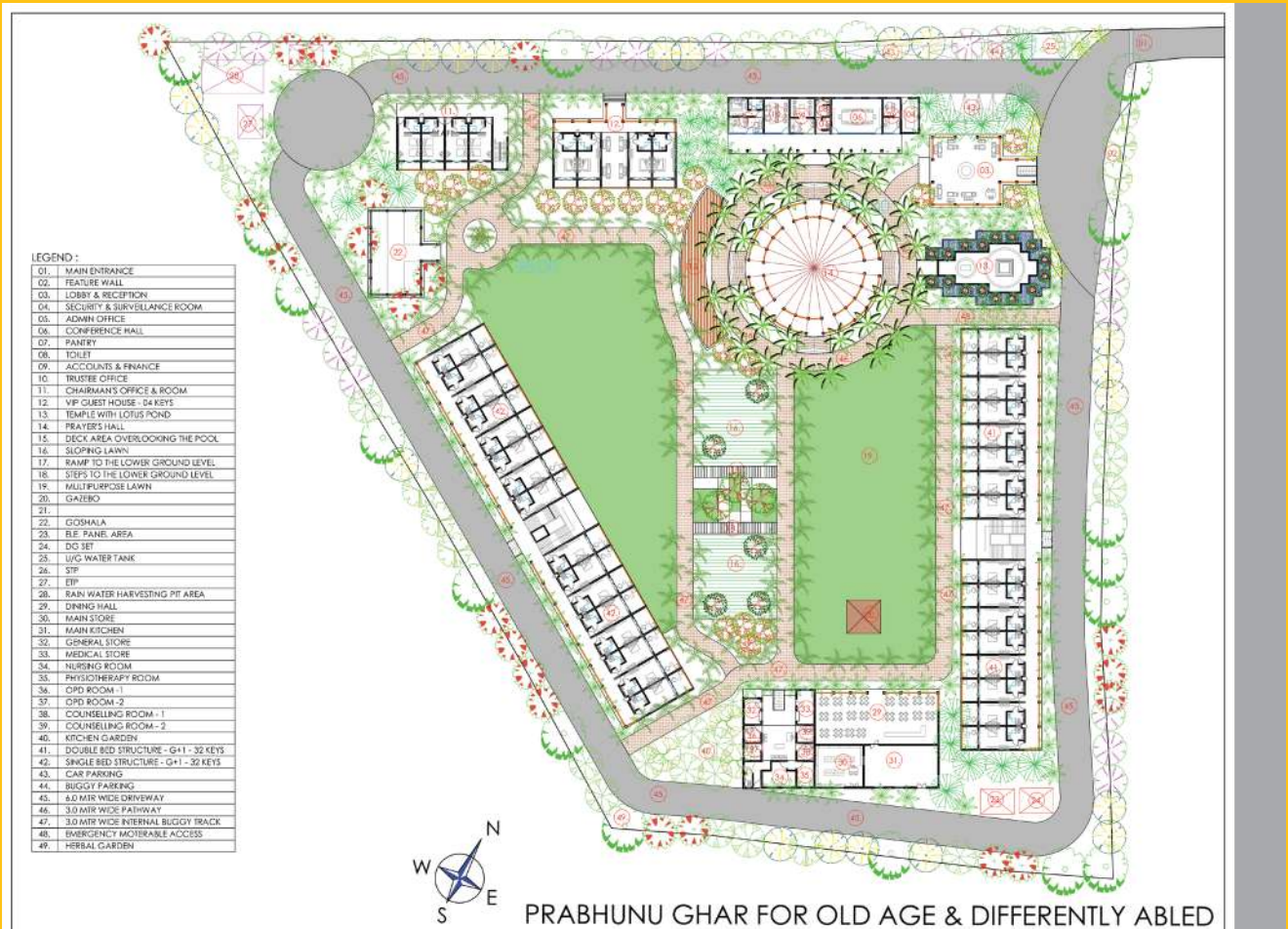
The first phase of the old age home, which is being built at an estimated cost of Rs. 12 crores, is nearing its completion.

Starts continuous and accurate monitoring of Solar and Wind Farms, Efficiency grows.

Customer satisfaction is KP Group's priority. KP Group has always been committed to delivering excellent production through state of art facilities and has made every effort to do so. Collection of solar power generation data via SCADA system and reporting to customers on hourly basis, continuous monitoring through CCTV camera network, increasing solar panel work efficiency by implementing robotic cleaning systems, are few of the initiatives taken by the group. Now moving forward, KP Group has established a centralized Network Operations Center (NOC) at its head office in Surat. It provides customers with live access along with data analysis, enabling them to view their solar or wind farm from any location and receive data on power generation. Through the Centralized Monitoring System (CMS) and the Network Operations Center (NOC), KP Group's team has given a new approach to Operations & Maintenance (O&M). This system has enabled the group to be more capable of immediate inspection, analysis, and resolution of any issues, leading to an increase in the efficiency of the solar-wind farm and a reduction in downtime.



Benefits of Implementing NOC (Network Operation Centre)



1. Continuous Monitoring for Predictive Maintenance Management

This centralized monitoring system oversees all aspects of solar, wind, and hybrid plants and collects real-time data with the help of SCADA systems within the plants. Continuous monitoring helps in identifying irregularities and potential issues, facilitating real-time resolution.

2. Optimal Performance & Management

By implementing advanced analytics and machine learning algorithms, this CMS predicts maintenance needs based on historical data and current trends. This allows for pre-emptive

resolution of potential issues before they impact the generation capacity of solar, wind, or hybrid farms, reducing downtime and enhancing power generation.

3. 24x7 Monitoring with the Network Operations Center

The implementation of this Network Operations Center, operational 365 days a year and working round the clock, demonstrates KP Group's commitment to excellence. This center serves as the nerve center for our O&M activities, allowing our experts to monitor and assess the performance and safety of the company's solar and wind power generation plants in real-time. It also aids in making informed decisions

regarding deployment based on maintenance needs.

4. Assistance through Automatic Report Generation

This CMS generates customized automatic reports, which empower management to make data-based decisions regarding maintenance schedules and other operational aspects. It also ensures transparency by providing customers with access to these reports. In case of any issues arising in the plant, these reports facilitate prompt action, maintaining continuous efficiency of the plant. Additionally, the data collected through this advanced technology enables the Network Operations Center to assist in more efficient planning and future projections.



KP Green Engineering's flight: Received orders worth **Rs. 351 crores**

KP Green Engineering made an official announcement on June 5, 2024, stating that the company has received orders worth Rs. 351.35 crores from various clients for projects including railway track fencing, solar projects, and electricity transmission line tower, crash barrier manufacturing. The company has received an order for a solar project worth Rs. 212.38 crores, which includes fixed tilt module mounting structure, tracker type module

mounting structure, and structure parts. The company has also received an order for a transmission line tower worth Rs. 79.51 crores, which includes tower material from 20 kV to 400 kV, a set of 33 kV and 66 kV substation equipment, hardware, cable tray, GI strip material, GI structure for isolator. Furthermore, the company has received an order for a project worth Rs. 52.54 crores, which includes a 180 megawatt pooling substation project, 33 kV

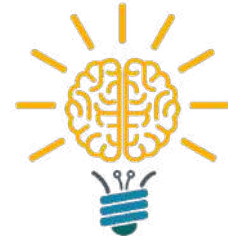

Along with KPI Green Energy, five other companies were also in the fray. The project is to be connected to the main grid, for which contracts have been signed.
